John 6:15-21

Jesus walks on water; the signs lead us to believe in Jesus.

The people tried to make Jesus their king.

People were often trying to get Jesus to follow a path other than the one that the Father had planned for Him.

We often want to make Jesus who we want Him to be.

When they try to force Him to become king, He withdraws to the mountain by Himself; He goes to spend time with the Father.

We are to stay connected to the Father that we might seek and know His will for our lives.

The disciples get in a boat to cross over to Capernaum; they are doing what they have been directed to do.

The disciples face bad weather as they are following the instructions of Jesus.

What can happen when we are obedient to Jesus?

Jesus sees the struggle of the disciples and comes to them.

The Lord comes to us in the midst of the difficulties and struggles that we face in life.

We need the help of Jesus as we walk through the struggles and as we serve Him.

The disciples kept rowing; we are called to keep serving and keep trying.
